

WAYS TO MODIFY MATERIALS

A. Content

- Alter the content involves adjusting the educational material. This can include:
 - Same theme or topic
 - More relatable content
 - Emphasizing key concepts

B. Educational Goals

- Modify the educational goals to be more attainable and relevant for the student. Ensure these goals still contribute to the overall learning objectives for the student.
 - Altering educational goals involves revising the objectives or outcome

C. Conceptual Difficulty

- Adjust the complexity of the concepts and ideas presented in educational content to match the learning needs and abilities of students.
 - Reduce the complexity or quantity of the information covered to match the student's capacity, using simpler language, and/or concrete examples.

D. Instructional Methods

Incorporate different teaching strategies by changing the approaches or techniques used by educators

- Could involve incorporating technology
- Shift from teacher-centered approaches to student-centered activities. Examples include hands-on activities, group projects, problem-based learning, peer teaching, and discussions
